# TOOLKIT HS-02: Prohibition Safety Signs

The prohibition safety sign indicates actions that you **MUST NOT** do. It is recognized by the bold red circle with a diagonal bar running from the top left to the bottom right. The pictogram is displayed in black with this circle overlaying it. Examples of this sign type are No Smoking signs, Do not touch signs and No exit signs.
