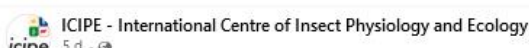

The challenges associated with #fallarmyworm (FAW) include high chemical pesticide usage and increased yield losses. In Africa, the yield loss amounts up to USD 9.4 billion per year; in Kenya alone, yield losses add up to 11- 5.5%. Hence, there is need for active engagement towards coming up with ideas for bio-based pest control. Great achievements will be made when #scientists in various countries agree to always share information.

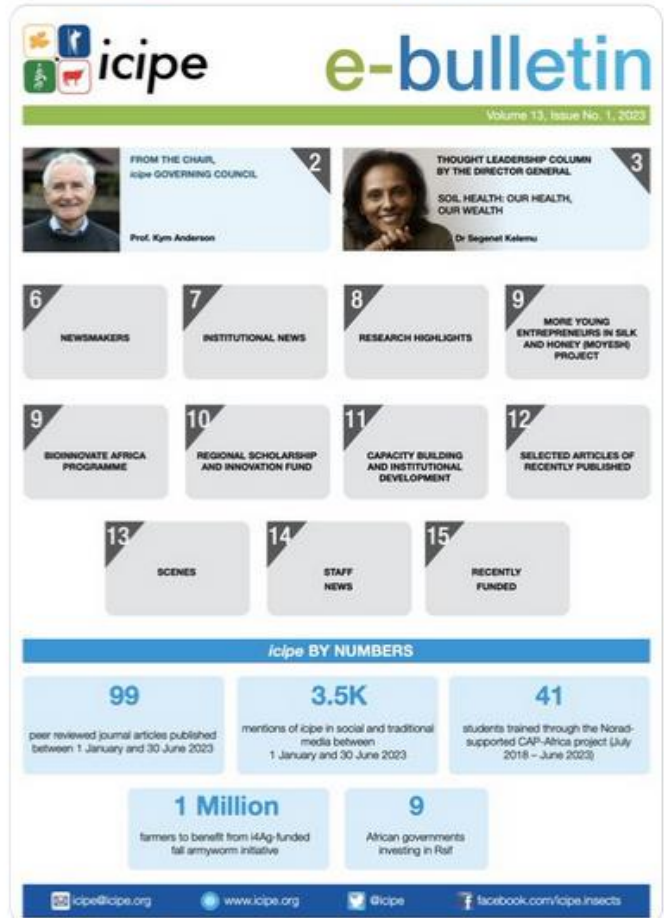
